- · Training can be done in a classroom setting or online




- For Owner & Contractor the Boilermakers report to work safety trained and ready to work


% in lost time

since 1989








Year to Date BOILERMAKER INJURY RATES FOR POPULATION COVERED BY STUDY









THE MOST COMMON ARC PROGRAM

- MOST owns the data and the equipment, but the program is a separate non-profit entity
- Program developed to simplify the qualification of Boilermakers for welding on job sites
 - Mass qualification tests take place throughout the country
 - Qualifications based on pass/fail method
 - Certified by Contractors
 - 6 month certification
- · Program defines welder performance



THE MOST COMMON ARC PROGRAM

- · Establishes unified welding code
- Eliminates redundancy of welding tests
- Created a central location of welder performance documentation
 - Enables ability to match welder specific skill sets to meet Owner and/or job site requirements
 - Provides for special pre-certification based on Owner requests if necessary
 - Enables timely dispatch of welders with appropriate skill sets
 - All benefits result in high levels of efficiency and productivity



THE MOST COMMON ARC PROGRAM

REDUCED % COSTS associated with welder certification

Elimination of redundant tests reduce costs — on site testing costs \$800 to \$1,000 per test.



THE MOST BOILERMAKER RESERVES PROGRAM

- Inception 1989
- Boilermakers throughout the country have a central location to obtain details and requirements for work
- Members in good standing can call or visit online to obtain the data
- 17,776 members have access
- Program is unique because the technology is in place to support members quickly and effectively



THE MOST BOILERMAKER RESERVES PROGRAM

- · Central location for project specific information
- · Average member calls 22 times per year
- Offers a cost-effective method of communicating
- · Helps to define upcoming work preparation tool
 - Effective in attracting skilled Boilermakers nationwide
 - Large projects or high demand periods
- Provides real-time access to upcoming work



THE MOST BOILERMAKER RESERVES PROGRAM

Contributes to supplying MANPOWER NEEDS during peak periods



THE MOST SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM

- Industry model since 1991
- Became a mandatory program in 1996 Boilermakers are the only Building & Construction Trade Department (BCTD) union to require mandatory testing
- · Site specific random tests are conducted throughout the year
- · Failed test results in an automatic 21-day suspension




THE MOST SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM

- · Establishes a benchmark for the industry
- Ensures future work for members if drug free
- Contributes to 90% reduction in lost time injuries
- Contributes to 90% reduction in compensable rates

THE MOST VERIFICATION PROGRAM

- An online and/or phone verification system allowing members and Contractors access to information regarding Boilermakers throughout the country
 - Verify status of drug tests
 - Verify training classes taken
 - Verify Common Arc certification
- Nearly 34,715 participants and 910 Contractors who access it
- · Been in place since 1991 (online since 2001)
- Program works in conjunction with MBDS



THE MOST VERIFICATION PROGRAM

- Participating members can prove they are current with tests and authorizations, visually verify themselves and access the system
- Instant verification 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Immediate access
- Keeps costs low through verification process —
 I.E. redundant drug tests

THE MOST SAFETY EYEWEAR PROGRAM

- Boilermakers may request prescription safety glasses through MOST
- Since the early 1990's over 24,000 pairs of safety glasses issued
- · Requests may be made every six months for new glasses
- · Prescription paperwork required every two years
- · Weekly average is 50 pairs distributed



THE MOST SAFETY EYEWEAR PROGRAM

- Helps to reduce the number of costly eye related injuries
- · Specific to the Boilermaker needs
- · No cost to the Boilermaker

THE MOST FORECASTING PROGRAM

- Web based tracking system for anticipated manpower demand at local, regional and national levels
- Projections to include local lodge membership information with surplus and deficit information highlighted
- System allows for workload preparation shutdowns and ramp ups
- · Locals and Contractors have access, Owners upon request
- Each Local is to maintain



THE MOST FORECASTING PROGRAM

- Provides a national road map of manpower needs for outage planning
- · Provides a central location for manpower records
- Real-time information on nationwide Boilermaker demand
- · No cost to access
- Preparation and management tool



THE MOST FORECASTING PROGRAM

THE MOST INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

- Exclusive with Slippery Rock University
- Establishes opportunities for Owners and Contractors to find and employ as safety experts college graduates who have degrees in Construction Safety and Health
- 6 month total program with a 3 month obligation to SRU



THE MOST INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

- Creates opportunities for students, Contractors, Owners and MOST
- · Solidifies relationships among Contractors and Owners
- · Provides educated students without the search element
- · Companies who have hired interns previously:
 - Nooter Corp.
 - CBI
 - Babcock & Wilcox
 - Thomas O'Connor Company
 - Kiewit Power Constructors



THE MOST INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Providing construction SAFETY & HEALTH professionals for the industry



THE MOST PROJECT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

- 50 hour course coordinated with Cornell University FMI certifies the program
- Designed to provide Supervisors and Project Managers with ability to manage projects in a business like fashion, which includes:
 - Make positive decisions that impact project goals
 - Provide an overall benefit to the Owner, the Contractor, the Boilermaker and other Union crafts
- Eligible participants MUST be nominated and apply
- Course work based on criteria established by Union,
 Contractor and Owner representatives



THE MOST PROJECT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

- · Elevates Boilermaker skills and reputation
- · A 'payback' to members who exude excellence
- Sets the bar high for apprentices and encourages dedication to the <u>craft</u>



THE MOST PROJECT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Prepares Boilermakers to manage projects



THE MOST SCAFFOLDING PROGRAM

- Two part course Scaffold User Course and Scaffold Erector/Dismantler Course
- · Course structure ensures Boilermaker safety and productivity
- Reviewed by OSHA and meets training requirement of OSHA 1926 Subpart L
- Scaffold User Course is a component of OSHA 30-hour course with emphasis on hazard recognition and training
- Scaffold Erector/Dismantler Course is a hands on course with emphasis on erection and dismantling of various scaffolds



THE MOST SCAFFOLDING PROGRAM

- · Raises the safety knowledge level of the Boilermaker
- Identifies the hazards of scaffold erection and dismantling
- · Provides pre-job training and authorization
- Documented proof provided upon completion of the course
- · Aspect of the overall safety training program



THE MOST SCAFFOLDING PROGRAM

Trains the boilermaker in SAFELY ERECTING and dismantling scaffolding



THE MOST STEEL ERECTION PROGRAM

- I day course
- Reviewed by OSHA and meets training requirement of OSHA 1926 Subpart R
- · Given at the Local level
- Steel erection course is a component of OSHA
 30-hour course with emphasis on hazard recognition and training
- · Focus is on erecting steel safely and competently



THE MOST STEEL ERECTION PROGRAM

- · Raises the safety knowledge level of the Boilermaker
- · Identifies the hazards of erecting steel
- · Provides pre-job training and authorization
- Documented proof provided upon completion of the course
- · Aspect of the overall safety training program



THE MOST STEEL ERECTION PROGRAM

Trains the boilermaker to

SAFELY ERECT STEEL



THE MOST RIGGING PROGRAM

- Class consists of four modules
 - Four (4) modules in three (3) 8-hour days
- Supplements BNAP training
- Allows for journeymen upgrading
- · Includes a separate train the trainer function



THE MOST RIGGING PROGRAM

- · Specific to the Boilermaker
- · A detailed rigging curriculum was developed
- · Raises the safety knowledge level of the Boilermaker
- · Identifies the hazards associated with rigging
- · Provides pre-job training and authorization
- Aspect of the overall safety training programs are enhanced and improved

THE MOST RECRUITMENT PROGRAM

- All MTR's (MOST Training Representative) are OSHA 500 instructors
- · All MTR's are responsible for:
 - Teaching safety training, steel erection, scaffold training and supplemental rigging classes
 - Seeking out potential Boilermakers
 - Arranging drug testing
 - Conducting unannounced audits for OSHA 10, 30, Supplemental Rigging, Steel and Scaffold training to ensure consistency



THE MOST RECRUITMENT PROGRAM

- Field representatives are seeking and recruiting the best qualified candidates to support manpower needs
- Ensure consistency among training facilities



THE MOST RECRUITMENT PROGRAM

Supplements the workforce with

Drug Tested, Safety Trained and Qualified

Boilermakers



THE MOST LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

- Formerly called Foreman's Training through the IBB's BNAP
- Program has been rewritten and specific to MOST criteria in conjunction with FMI
- Designed to provide Boilermaker Supervisors, Foreman and Field Managers with strategies and tools to manage and motivate field personnel safely and profitably
- Objectives are to provide training to Front Line supervisors on:
 - Administrative responsibilities
 - People skills
 - The business aspect of construction



THE MOST LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

- · Encourages communication and trust
- · Polishes the skills of existing Boilermakers
- Enhance the performance of Field Supervisors
- Enable the Union and Contractors to jointly provide a higher level of service to our Owners



THE MOST LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

Educates, Trains and Prepares job site foremen



THE MOST BOILERMAKER DELIVERY SYSTEM

- Centralized, web-based portal that connects
 Local lodge, Boilermaker members and Contractors
- Provides real time member availability, project opportunity and manpower demands
- · Accessible via smartphone, tablet or laptop



THE MOST BOILERMAKER DELIVERY SYSTEM

- Members confirm availability and register for Travelers Pool
- Members confirm certifications, qualifications and referral records
- Local Lodge receive and process Contractors job orders/termination slips, dispatch/maintain job applicants and invoke penalties as required
- Contractors view and request Boilermakers by name or skill level
- Contractors submit job orders, receive manpower referral and termination submissions
